## For Your Information

### IN THE CASE OF ILLNESS

# What We Ask of Second Grade Parents

### A. Help your child learn to be RESPONSIBLE

- 1. Children are here on time
- 2. Library books/homework returned on time
- 3. Notes signed and returned
- 4. Establish a homework routine

### B. Provide a lunch for your child

- 1. Take care of lost lunch money problems
- 2. Please take care of lunch money accounting

### C. Adequate DIET and REST for your child

- 1. Healthy breakfast each day
- 2. Reasonable and consistent bedtime
- 3. Keep child home when they are sick

### D. Follow-Up

- 1. Go over papers together
- 2. Praise and encouragement
- 3. Play and laugh together . . . celebrate your uniqueness
- 4. Read at home ... together and independently
- 5. Know where your child is going after school and with whom

### E. Encouragement and support

- 1. Ponations and supplies
- 2. Willingness to be involved in and out of the classroom
