Dear Sycamore Community,

Welcome Back!

It's so great to see all the kids after Spring Break and hear about their adventures. It's hard to believe that there are only 34 days left of school!

Reminder: Playground Open in the Morning

This week we returned to having the 1st-5th grade playground open for recess in the morning (from 7:45-8:00).

- Parents are now encouraged to drop off their children at the gate so that children can engage with their peers, playing on the playground in the morning.
- We are increasing our adult supervision on the playground in the morning there will be additional teachers on the yard to supervise students.
- Students will be able to play on the play structure or blacktop.
- No equipment will be out for students to use as the playtime is short and we don't want to lose instructional time.
- At 8:00am, the bell will ring and all students will line up at their line up spots. Teachers will pick up students at 8:00am at their line up spot.

After school, we will continue with our current procedures. At 2:30pm, students will be released to line up on the blacktop and should wait in their line up spot until they are picked up by their parents. No students or siblings of students should be playing on our playground between 2:30-2:40. Any students not picked up by 2:40pm will be brought to the office and their parents will be called.

Abilities Awareness Week


