First Day Drop Off and Pick-Up Information

You are welcome to come to our playground before school (at 7:45) and wait with your child until your child's teacher comes to pick them up at 8:00. This will give you a chance to give a quick wave to your child's teacher that morning before you get to see them again in person the following night for Back to School Night.

Kindergarten families should have received information about drop off and pick up for their special shortened day visit on the first day of school.

Back to School Night

We are looking forward to seeing you at our Back to School Night on Wednesday, August 11th. This year we are having all families come on ONE EVENING. In the past we welcomed some grade levels on one night and other grade levels on a different night. All grades will be coming on August 11th (the second day of school). Here are the times:

Please note that in lieu of all families gathering in the MPR, my message to the community will be recorded and shown IN CLASSROOMS. This means that for TK-2, you will stay put in your classroom from 6:00-6:20 to hear the message. For 3-5 families, you will need to arrive before 6:00 and be in your child's classroom by 6:00 to watch the presentation. If you miss it, I will be sharing the video out in Shark Bites that week!

Music, Music, Music!

We are THRILLED to announce that music is returning to Sycamore for ALL students in grades TK-5th this year. For our TK through 2nd grade students, vocal music will be offered once a week for 30 minutes. This will be provided during the school day. Your classroom donations of \$195 help to cover the cost of this new program! For our 4th and 5th grade students, instrumental music will be offered (mostly) before school from 7:30-8:00 with the

exception of Advanced Band which will be a pull out between 8:10-8:40 on Fridays. We have two new teachers who will be working with students. Ms. Shiva Samimi will be our TK-2 music teacher and Mr. Lotan Yeung will be our 3-5 music teacher. We are all so excited to have this music program in place for our Sharks!

School Counselor

This year we have additional support for the social emotional well-being of our students. We will have a school counselor at our site, two and a half days a week. We are so lucky to have Ms. Sarah Reardon join us on Thursdays and Fridays and every other Wednesday. She will be spending most of her day working directly with students, supporting them 1:1., in small groups and on the playground.

Tech Support is Back on Campus

We are excited to announce that SRVUSD has returned to having tech support available on campus every morning. Celia Hensger is joining our Sycamore team and will be supporting teachers and students as we move to an almost 1:1 model of devices in classrooms.

Devices for Students

Almost all grade levels will start the year with a 1:1 for devices. Grades 2-5 will have Chromebooks and Grades TK-1 will have iPads. Second grade will start the year with one device for every two students, but we are hopeful that gap will close sometime soon and our second graders will also be at 1:1 with Chromebooks.
