Happy New Year Sycamore Community! I hope you all had a wonderful break. It is so fun to get to see the kids this week and hear all the fun adventures they had over the break - from staying home and eating great food to trips to Tahoe for skiing and snow play.

Over the course of January, we will be using a part of the Principal's section of Shark Bites to do a "NEW YEAR REVIEW" that focuses on reviewing procedures/providing updates for procedures here on campus. This week, we will focus on reviewing our morning drop off guidelines.

NEW YEAR REVIEW: Drop Off Reminders

Grades 1-5 Arrival at School (8:00 am)

We encourage our parents/guardians to utilize the carpool pick-up lane as it is the safest way to minimize contact between community members. However, we recognize that, especially for our youngest students, drop off and pick-up in person may be the best option.

Students who are being dropped off in vehicles at carpool:

It is important to drive slowly and watch for children and adults. You must remain in your vehicle at all times if you are using the carpool drop off lane. Teachers will be there to help open doors of vehicles and safely get children out of the car.

Please do not "cut" the line unless a staff member waves you forward. Additionally, it is important that you wait until you are in one of the designated drop off spots in front of the school before you let your child exit your vehicle. When families drop off ahead of the designated spots, it often ends up creating a traffic jam. If you do not want to wait in the drop off line, you can pull into the parking lot and walk your child to the crosswalk, and they can cross safely to school.

You may drop off your 1st-5th grader in the morning no earlier than 7:45 am. There is adult

supervision on the big kid playground blacktop starting at 7:45 am. We have had a lot of children being dropped off before 7:45. We are concerned for their safety as there are no adults on the blacktop at that time.

Students who are being dropped off in person:

If you would like to accompany your child onto the playground, please park in the parking lot and remain on the playground blacktop with your child. Students will line up at their classroom number and wait for the bell to ring at 8:00am. No children should be playing on the play structure or on the yard before school starts. At 8:00 am teachers will walk to the blacktop and get their students. All adults must leave the playground at 8:00 am, as we have P.E. classes that will use the blacktop beginning at 8:10 am.

Students who are walking:

Students can enter the playground no earlier than 7:45 am. Students may enter through the front playground gates or the gate that leads to the back path and should line up at their classroom numbers.

Grade 1 Late Shark Arrival (8:40)

Students who are being dropped off in vehicles at carpool:

See above information. A staff member will be there to help open doors of vehicles and safely get children out of the car. You may drop off your late shark 1st grader in the morning no earlier than 8:30 am. Students will wait outside the front gates until 8:40. At 8:40 the staff member will walk the students to their appropriate classrooms.

Students who are being dropped off in person:

If you would like to accompany your child to the front of the school, please park in the parking lot and remain in front of the school with your child. The gates will open at 8:40 am for students to go to their classroom. At 8:40 the school staff member will walk the students to their appropriate classrooms. No parents are allowed on campus.

Covid Updates

As you have read in our daily emails, we have had a few positive cases on our campus this week. Here is some information that may be helpful to your family:

- If you choose to have your child vaccinated, please provide a copy of the vaccination card, showing both shot dates, to our school office.
- If your child has an exposure or test positive, please notify our school office ASAP.
- Home Test Kits are now approved for test results.






Please Take One & Leave One (if you can):


