Read Aloud - March: Creativity:

During the month of March we will focus on the Character Trait of CREATIVITY. Creativity is the use of the imagination or coming up with original ideas. Our read aloud book is called, Someone Builds the Dream. This book is an exploration of the many types of work that go into building our world–from the making of a bridge to a wind farm, an amusement park, and a picture book.



However, while the book celebrates the dreamer, it also recognizes that the dreamer isn't always the person who makes the dream come true. An architect may dream up the plans for a house, but someone has to actually work the saws and pound the nails. This book acknowledges the creativity of the dreamers but also gives recognition to the crews of skilled people, using some very impressive equipment and working very hard for a long time, to actually build that dream. In her biographical note, the author states that she grew up in a family of steel workers and welders and that she hopes we learn to admire and respect the builders and their work in this book.

African American History Museum:

Our African American History Museum was a huge success! The kids did such a beautiful job on their artwork and our living history models did a fantastic job teaching about the lives of our artists. We had some special visitors come see our museum including Trustee Clark and Dr. Malloy. A huge thank you to Toby Silvestri for her creativity in coming up with the projects, to our leadership students for creating the posters of artists' names, to Joselito Tangco for all his hard work setting up the event, and to our PTA President Christy Lucia, PTA EVP Erin Meyer and our other PTA volunteers who hung artwork and posters, created brochures and signs, and took care of all of the set up and take down for the event.



Parent/Teacher Conferences:

As you may be aware, March 16th, 17th, and 18th are Parent/Teacher Conferences. Unlike October's Fall Parent/Teacher conferences, Spring Conferences are not for all students. The Spring conferences are by teacher invitation or parent request only. Just like in the fall, these conferences can be in person or virtual. 



Student work will be recorded and then returned the following month.

Science Builder's Challenge: This year's Science Builders' Challenge is Goldberg's Garage. Students will find creative ways to complete several action transfers (kinetic energy) by using a variety of simple machines, thus combining to form a complex machine! This project applies the concept of a Rube Goldberg machine, which uses a complicated series of actions to simply move an object from one place to another, usually in a unique, fun, and indirect way. The project submission and showcase will be held on Monday, May 2nd, after school. Project requirements will be emailed to those that have signed up.

Science Fair: Students will answer your most pressing scientific questions using The Scientific Method and present their experiment and findings in a tri-fold poster board presentation. This year's Science Fair will be held on Wednesday, May 18th, after school. Judging will be held that afternoon and prizes will be awarded for Creativity, Presentation, and Most Unexpected Results. The projects and awards will be on display in the library during the school's Open House on Thursday, May 19th. Project requirements will be emailed to those that have signed up.




Please Take One & Leave One (if you can):
