Parent/Teacher Conferences:

As you may be aware, March 16th, 17th, and 18th are Parent/Teacher Conferences. Students will be following the Minimum Day schedule:

TK / K = 8:00am - 10:30am1st - 5th = 8:00am - 12:00pm

<u>Reminder</u>: Spring Parent/Teacher Conferences are not for all students. The Spring conferences are by teacher invitation or parent request only. These conferences can be in person or virtual. Teachers will have reached out directly to those families with whom they would like to meet.

Cell phones/Smart Watches:

I wanted to let you know about the increasing student use of cell phones and smart watches during the school day at Sycamore. At Sycamore Valley, students are not to have their phones/smart watches out at school during school hours. This means that from 7:45am when they step onto campus until 2:30pm when they are outside the school gates, phones should remain in backpacks and students should not be using their phones or smart watches. Students should not be texting, calling, using apps, videoing or taking photos during the school day. If a student needs to communicate with their family during the school day, students can go to the office and ask to call home. Similarly, if families need to reach their child during the day, they should call the

school office at 925-855-2800.

Pokémon Trading Cards:

We have begun to have some issues around students bringing Pokémon cards to school to trade and to play with. Unfortunately, we cannot regulate these games and students are often having large amounts of cards taken from them. As we cannot ensure that these games/trading activities are fair, **please do not allow your child to come to school with Pokémon cards.** While our staff has spoken with the children about this, we need your help to ensure that cards are lost, taken, or damaged. 

Student Class Placement Form 22-23

The Sycamore staff will be assigning students to classes for the 2022- 2023 school year during the month of May. Parents and students will be notified of teacher and classroom placement on August 8th, 2022.

Careful consideration is given to the class placement of each student. The primary factors considered in class placement are:

- 1. Current year's teacher assessment of the student's needs;
- 2. Input from support staff resource, speech, school psychologist, reading specialists;
- 3. Class balance: academic performance, test scores, behavior, and boy/girl ratio;
- 4. Physical, medical, emotional and social development of the child;
- 5. Parent information regarding student's specific needs.

This form is not required, however if you believe your child has specific needs and/or excels in a particular type of classroom environment that the staff should consider when placing him/her, describe them below. Please do not request specific teachers. Letters that state a specific teacher's name or that tries to describe a specific teacher will not be considered.
