Independent Study

If your family is going to be away from school for 5 or more consecutive days, please follow the directions below regarding requesting an Independent Study Contract for those pre-determined absences. By requesting a contract, your child(ren) will be given work to complete during their absence. Upon your child's return, they will submit the work they did and, once reviewed, the school will be able to receive ADA funding for the days missed. As a reminder, daily ADA funding is approximately \$70 per child. Without the contract, your child risks falling behind and our school loses out on funding.

While you can let your child's teacher know you are going to be leaving, you must fill out the Independent Study Request Form (see link below) and notify the staff in the school office to initiate the process. Teachers will only be able to provide work if the independent study contract request is completed.

Here are some of the procedures for requesting an independent study contract.

- 5-10 consecutive instructional day independent study contract: Must request at least three days in advance.
- 11-14 consecutive instructional day independent study contract: Must request and contact the principal five to ten days in advance.



Student Class Placement Form 22-23

The Sycamore staff will be assigning students to classes for the 2022- 2023 school year during the month of May. Parents and students will be notified of teacher and classroom placement on August 8th, 2022.

Careful consideration is given to the class placement of each student. The primary factors considered in class placement are:

- 1. Current year's teacher assessment of the student's needs;
- 2. Input from support staff resource, speech, school psychologist, reading specialists;
- 3. Class balance: academic performance, test scores, behavior, and boy/girl ratio;
- 4. Physical, medical, emotional and social development of the child;
- 5. Parent information regarding student's specific needs.

This form is not required, however if you believe your child has specific needs and/or excels in a particular type of classroom environment that the staff should consider when placing him/her, describe them below. Please do not request specific teachers. Letters that state a specific teacher's name or that tries to describe a specific teacher will not be considered.

Science Builder's Challenge: This year's Science Builders' Challenge is Goldberg's Garage. Students will find creative ways to complete several action transfers (kinetic energy) by using a variety of simple machines, thus combining to form a complex machine! This project applies the concept of a Rube Goldberg machine, which uses a complicated series of actions to simply move an object from one place to another, usually in a unique, fun, and indirect way. The project submission and showcase will be held on Monday, May 2nd, after school. Project requirements have been emailed to those that signed up. See the SLAM website for project details.

Science Fair: Students will answer your most pressing scientific questions using The Scientific Method and present their experiment and findings in a tri-fold poster board presentation. This year's Science Fair will be held on Wednesday, May 18th, after school. Judging will be held that afternoon and prizes will be awarded for Creativity, Presentation, and Most Unexpected Results. The projects and awards will be on display in the library during the school's Open House on Thursday, May 19th. Project requirements have been emailed to those that signed up.
