This past Tuesday our teachers were hard at work here at school! We were so lucky to have Kara Teach, the inclusion specialist for SRVUSD, talk to our staff about the social-emotional/behavioral needs of our students and share strategies on how to best support all of our students. We also spent time working in our Professional Learning Community groups and getting more training in implementing Schoology.

SEL at Sycamore

This year, more than ever, we are focusing on the social emotional learning and wellbeing of our students. As a school, we continue to focus on our monthly Character Traits through shared read aloud books that all students in grades TK-5 get to hear. This year, we have added certificates honoring the positive behavior of our students. Additionally, our teachers are supporting our students in various ways, from Mrs. Crosthwait's "Cup of Conversation" to Mrs. Vasconi's deep dive into Social Thinking. Each of our teachers are finding their own way to ensure our students have a safe space to talk and learn.

This week, Mrs. O'Malley's second graders got to create a "recipe for success" at recess. This week the students brainstormed various character traits needed to be a good friend out at recess (empathy, kindness, patience, etc.). Today, students were able to dress as chefs and combine real food ingredients that symbolized the various character traits. Students in her class will continue to

discuss how to have a "recipe for success" in various areas of school (classroom, library, hallway). Here are some cute photos from today's lesson:




