Great Shake Out:

Today we had our Great Shake Out. Students practiced ducking and covering in our classrooms. We then headed out to the playground to practice our evacuation drill. The kids did a wonderful job and made it outside and back in their fastest time.

First "Rainy Day" Lunch:

Today we had our first test run of a "rainy day" lunch. Our students in grades 1 and 3 ate inside the cafeteria due to the wet soggy ground outside. Thankfully, the rest of the grades were able to eat outside as the skies had cleared! For our students who ate indoors, we were able to keep them spaced out 6 feet apart. Students sat on the ground in the MPR and were given a wax paper "placemat" to put their food on. We also let them head to the playground as soon as they were done eating so that they were not unmasked inside for any longer than they had to be. Our first and third graders did a wonderful job!

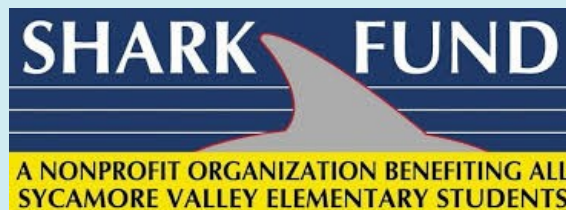
School Picture packages are due to arrive close to October 20th. The photos are mailed to the home address on file. Families that purchased the digital image have already received them.
