Dear Sycamore Families:

I hope all is well with you and your family. It has been another great week here at Sycamore Valley! Next week we will be thinking about being healthy during Red Ribbon Week. More information about Red Ribbon Week will be coming out tomorrow.

Following are some reminders, information about the "One Chip Challenge", CogAT retakes, Lost and Found (which is starting to overflow!), protocols for medication on campus, goings on around campus and Halloween. Keep reading!

REMINDERS:

Halloween Parade: Monday, October 31st No School on Tuesday, November 1st Daylight Savings Time - Roll back, Sunday, November 6th

One Chip Challenge:

We want to warn everyone of a dangerous social media trend called the "One Chip Challenge," where students eat an extremely spicy chip sold by the chip brand, Paqui. Students can fall ill and have severe symptoms such as vomiting, stomachache, mouth burning and more. Some students in other districts have needed to go to the emergency room to receive care. Please talk with your student about the risks of engaging in this challenge.

Assigned Parking Spot:

In our main parking lot, we have 2 spots that have been purchased at our school auction by 2 families. Please refrain from parking in these assigned spot at any time.

CogAT:

An optional CogAT exam will be offered on Saturday, January 28, 2023. Registration opens on **Tuesday**, **Oct. 18 at 8:00am and will close on Nov. 20 at Midnight**. SRVUSD will be offering the CogAT exam for all students new to the district who have never taken it and for 3rd and 4th grade students who have taken it once previously and would like another try. The CogAT exam is used for GATE identification and ATP eligibility. Register from **October 18 at 8am to November 20 at Midnight** on the <u>Gate Testing page</u> of the district website. *Late registrations will not be accepted*

NOTE: All 2nd grade families will receive information about their CogAT testing opportunity in the Spring of 2023.

Lost & Found:

It is that time of year where our lost and found grows quickly. Please remember to write your child's last name on their garments. If you are missing any items, remind your child to check the Lost and Found. The Lost and Found rack is located in front of our MPR. Unclaimed garments are donated to a local charity twice a year.

Medication on Campus:

Students are not allowed to carry medication in their backpack or in their pockets. This week we found a Claritin tablet near one of our classrooms. If this had gotten into the wrong hands, it could have been a serious situation. Therefore, please do not send ANY medication to school, with your child. All medication must be locked in our school office.

Goings On Around Campus:

Cain's Arcade:

On October 11th the 5th grade students participated in the ultimate STEM Challenge. The students created arcade games at school using only cardboard, tape, paper and string. It seems our 5th graders are getting more creative each year. They learned a lot and had fun too!

Danville Police Department stopped by during lunch time on Monday to hang out with our students on the playground. Everyone had a great time. Several students played Red Light/Green Light with the officers. Most of the students were given a sticker that looks like a police badge. And one of the officers enjoyed swinging with the students.







Halloween:

Halloween is fast approaching and there are a few things to note: Halloween is a Monday, October 31st and it is a full day of school. **Halloween parade** - Grades TK-5th will participate in the Halloween parade. The parade will begin at 9:30 on the turf field on the other side of the parking lot. Following the parade, students will return to campus to resume the usual schedule. Campus is not open to parents during the school day unless you have signed up to volunteer for a specific assignment.

Costumes - Students need to be able to put on and take off their costume independently. Students may wear a mask during the parade but need to be able to see clearly when walking. We do ask that parents refrain from wearing a mask and that all costumes are respectful of various cultures. Wearing a traditional costume from a culture other than your own and/or wearing face make-up to appear as a person from an ethnicity other than your own is not respectful and can undermine the inclusive community we are building here at Sycamore Valley.

Class Parties - Individual classes will share the details for their Halloween parties including requests for any needed volunteers. The parties are for

the children only. Volunteers for the parties will need to be cleared ahead of time through Be A Mentor and signed in at the office.


