Take a look at the rack and in the yellow bin.


You may be surprised and find a sweatshirt / jacket / or sweater that you did not know was left behind.

The first WordMasters challenge takes place this month. Students can complete the challenge at home between **November 11th - November 29th**.

STEAM Art & Play:

The next class is **Tuesday**, **December 5th**, at 2:30pm in the MPR. Your child(ren) may only attend if they are signed up via the signup genius. Classes are FULL, so if your child(ren) cannot attend, please delete their signup so that their spot may be offered to someone on the waitlist.

SuperSTEM:




Sharky Cinema:


