Message from Patricia Kawahara - Principal November 17, 2022

Dear Sycamore Families:

November is Native American Heritage Month.

I hope you and your family are well. It has been a lovely, typical five day week with just a sprinkle of "special" as we get ready to head off to Thanksgiving Break. Kindergarten kiddos enjoyed a feast, friends across the grade levels have engaged in various turkey art projects, and our fifth graders have been busy designing floats for a digital parade.

On a more somber note, I would like to remind everyone of the car line protocols. Please remember to wait in the car line, even if you are running late. Cutting to the front of the line is dangerous as people at the curb are pulling out. Additionally, children must be dropped off at the right curb only. It is extremely dangerous for students to exit at the left curb and attempt to cross the road. Finally, please be patient and take your time. There is no need to rush, even if you are late. We will welcome your child to school when they arrive and ensure they are supervised and safe until you pick them up. The few moments difference between driving calmly or speeding up the hill do not make a difference. We appreciate your cooperation in helping to keep all of our students safe.

Reminders:

November 18 - Thanksgiving Luncheon for Students November 21-25 - Thanksgiving Break - No School <u>Message from the School Nurse</u>:

We are in the midst of the cold and flu season so a few reminders for students and staff. Please remind your student(s) to cough into their elbows and throw their tissues into the trash can. Immediately after blowing their nose, they should wash their hands or use sanitizer to disinfect their hands so they are not touching common areas with their hands.

We strongly recommend testing your child for Covid should they exhibit any Covid (flu-like) symptoms AND before their return to school after the Thanksgiving break.

Please see the attached chart to determine if you should keep your child at home or send them to school. <u>Guidelines</u>

Thank you so much. All your efforts are appreciated to keep our children healthy and safe at school.

COVID Test Kit Distribution:

The CDPH is continuing efforts to keep schools safe and successful by providing over-the-counter (OTC)/at-home COVID-19 rapid antigen tests for students and staff to use when returning from Thanksgiving Break. We are encouraging all students and staff to test for COVID-19 before they return to school following Thanksgiving Break, as testing remains a critical safety measure to reduce the possibility of an early 2023 surge. The kits will be sent home this week with all students and staff.

Danville P.D. Recess Visit:

Danville Police Officers visited with our students during lunch recess. They brought one of the police motorcycles for the students to see.

Please call the attendance line to report an absence: 925-855-2898

AR 5113 States that all absences which are not cleared within two days after a student's return to school shall be recorded as unexcused (CUT).

Reminder: If your child will be absent from school, please call the attendance line (925) 855-2898. State your name and relationship, your child's name, grade and teacher name along with the reason for absence. If your child is ill, please let us know what symptoms your child is experiencing.

If your child has COVID-19, please notify the school office. It is recommended that your child stay home for 5 days.

If you choose not to leave illness details, you will receive a call from the attendance office asking for more information.

It is our responsibility to maintain the health and safety of our school community and we ask for your cooperation. Your student's private health information will not be shared beyond administrative or nursing staff.

Special thanks to the classroom coordinators who helped organize our students in spirit wear and all the volunteers who came out to set up, encourage runners, and clean up!


