Dear Sycamore Valley Families,

I hope you had a restful and joy-filled break. Returning to Sycamore Valley this week was delightful. I have enjoyed catching with all of our Sycamore Sharks! This time between Thanksgiving and Winter Break is very busy with a lot of learning taking place. We started the week with the annual Street Smarts Assembly. This assembly focuses on road safety for pedestrians, cyclists, and scooter-riders.

In the classrooms our Sharks are learning about a variety of topics. TK students are focusing on the letter "g" and winter holidays. Kinder students are exploring the five senses. 1st graders are working on oral presentations centered on family holiday traditions. 2nd graders went to Lindsay Wildlife Museum. 3rd graders closed out their Mystery Reading unit with a visit from the *Code Buster* author Penny Warner (see photo below). 4th grade is digging into double digit multiplication and 5th grade is diving into non-fiction reading with self-selected topics.
