Dear Sycamore Valley Families,
I hope you had a restful and joy-filled break. Returning to Sycamore Valley this week was delightful. I have enjoyed catching with all of our Sycamore Sharks! This time between Thanksgiving and Winter Break is very busy with a lot of learning taking place. We started the week with the annual Street Smarts Assembly. This assembly focuses on road safety for pedestrians, cyclists, and scooter-riders.
In the classrooms our Sharks are learning about a variety of topics. TK students are focusing on the letter " 9 " and winter holidays. Kinder students are exploring the five senses. 1st graders are working on oral presentations centered on family holiday traditions. 2nd graders went to Lindsay Wildlife Museum. 3rd graders closed out their Mystery Reading unit with a visit from the Code Buster author Penny Warner (see photo below). 4th grade is digging into double digit multiplication and 5th grade is diving into non-fiction reading with self-selected topics.

## Please call the attendance line to report an absence: 925-855-2898

AR 5113 States that all absences which are not cleared within two days after a student's return to school shall be recorded as unexcused (CUT).

Reminder:

- If your child will be absent from school, please call the attendance line (925) 855-2898. State your name and relationship, your child's name, grade and teacher name along with the reason for absence. If your child is ill, please let us know what symptoms your child is experiencing.
- If your child has COVID-19, please notify the school office.
- If you choose not to leave illness details, you will receive a call from the attendance office asking for more information.
It is our responsibility to maintain the health and safety of our school community and we ask for your cooperation. Your student's private health information will not be shared beyond administrative or nursing staff.
