Depth and Complexity:

One of San Ramon Valley Unified School District's Strategic Directions is Deep Learning. Deep Learning has many components and takes shape in classrooms in different ways. An entry point for Deep Learning here at Sycamore Valley has been Depth and Complexity. Depth and Complexity is designed to foster deep thinking and lends itself easily to differentiation. The program centers on a series of icons that are referenced as visual prompts.

TK and Kindergarten students start with patterns. Over the years icons are added until fifth grade when students are considering patterns, details, unanswered questions, language as a discipline, big ideas, ethics, perspectives, changes over time, across disciplines, trends and rules. Teachers at different grade levels have been sharing the Depth and Complexity icons and frames to support students in delving deeper in their

analysis across the curriculum.



Does your child have a stack of paperback books sitting around the house they've already read? Do you wish you had the opportunity to exchange them for new stories and reading adventures? Then the Sycamore Valley PTA Book Swap is for you!

HOW IT WORKS

January 30 and January 31 students may bring and donate "gently used" paperback books. Donations will be made in front of the MPR before school (7:45–8:00 & 8:45-9:00 a.m.). Students may swap up to five (5) books but are encouraged to bring additional book donations. All remaining books after the swap will be donated to our Sister School, King Elementary.

On Wednesday February 1, students may come to the MPR after school, 12:50-2 p.m (TK and Kindergartners in the TK/Kindergarten Playground at 11:30 a.m.) and select a "new to them" book of their choice based upon the number of books they donated up to five (5). Students will trade one (1) ticket for one (1) book. Students will also receive a free bookmark designed by the Bookmark Contest Winner for their grade level.

BOOK CRITERIA

Books to be swapped should be FROM our students, FOR our students. Encourage your child to bring books they've loved that they think their friends might love too! Books will only be accepted under the following guidelines:

Books must be appropriate for grades TK-5

Books must be gently used condition: cover on, no rips, no tears, no coloring or writing in them NO preschool books, magazines, sticker books, coloring books, activity books, Young Adult or grown-up books

NO free books such as kids meals (McDonalds, Chick-fil-a) will be accepted

BOOKMARK CONTEST

We invite all of our talented Sycamore artists to participate in this year's "If you don't like to read, then you haven't found the right book" Bookmark

Contest. The winner from each grade level (TK thru 5) will receive a copy of their laminated bookmark as well as bragging rights as "official" bookmark winner at this year's Book Swap.

Entry forms are available in the office and online through Shark Bites. Completed Entries are due to the **Office** by January 20^{th} . ONE (1) entry per student. Artwork should be done by hand and by the child whose name is on the form.

Bookmark Contest Rules:

This year's theme is "If you don't like to read, you haven't found the right book." What's your favorite book? Use your imagination and creativity to design a bookmark that best represents that book. Make sure to write/include the book title on your entry! Open to all Sycamore Valley Elementary Students Grades TK-5.

- Bookmarks must be created using this template (on the left) with crayons, colored pencils, pens or markers. (Remember, winning bookmarks must be reproducible.)
- Original entries only. No tracing or copyrighted images like cartoons. No computer generated images.
- Only one (1) entry per student. Artwork should be done by hand and by the child whose name is on the form (exception: young children may receive help in writing letters and numbers!

Turn in your bookmark design entry to the OFFICE by January 20, 2023.

- · Winners will be chosen from each grade level (TK, K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th).
- · Winners will be judged on creativity, spelling and neatness, theme, and printability.
- Winners will be announced January 25th and will receive their bookmark back laminated as well as have their bookmark printed and given out at the fair.


