Message from Patricia Kawahara - Principal January 19, 2023

Dear Sycamore Families:

Happy Lunar New Year to all of our Sycamore Sharks who are celebrating!!

I hope everyone enjoyed the long weekend in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Over the past few weeks, the students have been working on lessons deepening their understanding of Dr. King and his message. In Mrs. Vasconi's class, for example, students selected a quote and explained what it means to them. Reading the work was a highlight of my week.

The sun has finally made a much anticipated return and we are all thrilled!! It is wonderful to be back outside enjoying the fresh air.

We are looking forward to the start of a four week stretch of five day weeks starting Monday. This is an opportunity to settle into routines. In order to support the efficacy of routines we ask that students attend school every day if they are not sick. Extra vacation days can undermine a student's progress and disrupt their connectedness to the class community. Plus, we love our Sharks and look forward to seeing them each day!

Absences:

If your child is out sick for multiple days, it is important that you call each day your child is out to clear the absence. This is really helpful in ensuring that we are documenting absences correctly.

Medical Issues:

If your child has a medical issue that will require some accommodations please be sure to communicate with the office. Examples of this include having to use crutches, a medical boot or a cast. In these instances, it is important that we communicate so we are clear on P.E. and recess considerations as well as classroom support that may be needed. A doctor's note is very helpful in informing this conversation.

Principal for the Day:

Addison C, third grade, had the distinguished honor of Principal for the Day. Addison read stories in multiple classrooms, including a fifth grade class where she used the doc cam like a pro, supervised recess, dismissed kiddos from lunch, checked in on the fourth grade and the TK kiddos, made the morning announcement, welcomed students at arrival and sent them on their way at the end of the day, and used the mega-phone to dismiss students back to class following the fire drill. It was a busy day! Students across the school enjoyed having a fellow student in charge. They were respectful and cheered Principal C on in her role. The day was another example of what a kind and respectful community we have at Sycamore Valley.





Volunteering / Chaperoning:

Parents/Caregivers who are volunteering at school or chaperoning field trips are also bounded by FERPA, as well as the SRVUSD

VOLUNTEER/DRIVER/CHAPERONE Protocols and Procedures, which states, "Confidentiality of information obtained through your volunteer efforts must remain confidential." When parents sign up through the Be A Mentor program, they must watch a **video** regarding "School Volunteers and FERPA" and certify they have watched it and understand their responsibilities. Please be sure to review this confidentiality agreement with your adult chaperones before the trip.



HOW IT WORKS

January 30 and January 31 students may bring and donate "gently used" paperback books. Donations will be made in front of the MPR before school (7:45–8:00 & 8:45-9:00 a.m.). Students may swap up to five (5) books but are encouraged to bring additional book donations. All remaining books after the swap will be donated to our Sister School, King Elementary.

On Wednesday February 1, students may come to the MPR after school, 12:50-2 p.m (TK and Kindergartners in the TK/Kindergarten Playground at 11:30 a.m.) and select a "new to them" book of their choice based upon the number of books they donated up to five (5). Students will trade one (1) ticket for one (1) book. Students will also receive a free bookmark designed by the Bookmark Contest Winner for their grade level.

BOOK CRITERIA

Books to be swapped should be FROM our students, FOR our students. Encourage your child to bring books they've loved that they think their friends might love too! Books will only be accepted under the following guidelines:

Books must be appropriate for grades TK-5

Books must be gently used condition: cover on, no rips, no tears, no coloring or writing in them NO preschool books, magazines, sticker books, coloring books, activity books, Young Adult or grown-up books

NO free books such as kids meals (McDonalds, Chick-fil-a) will be accepted


