Students can trade one (1) ticket for one (1) book at the Book Swap.

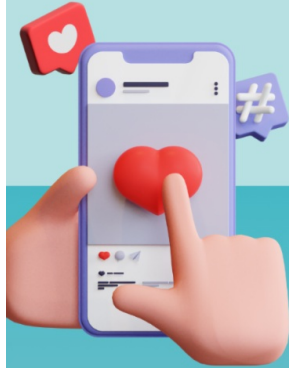

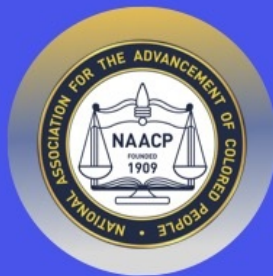
