

Dear Sycamore Valley Families,

I hope you and your family are well.

One of the components of Deep Learning (a SRVUSD strategic direction) is increasing opportunities for student ownership of their work. This can look different in various academic areas and across the grade levels. In 5th grade science this week, for example, it involved students collaborating on the development of a rubric for their Animals in the Ecosystems research project a project that embeds choice as students decide in what manner they will share their information. Each table group developed the criteria for scores in different areas of the rubric in alignment with the applicable California State Standards. The rubric created was rigorous and included all aspects of the project. I can't wait to see the finished products! Words Matter Assemblies:


