#### Character Trait of the Month:

This month's trait is Creativity. I have shared with the students that I tend to think of creativity in terms of the arts but in reading stories with them I am expanding my understanding to include creative thinking, imagination, and problem solving. Some fun titles that we are looking at are *The Big Orange Splot* by Daniel Manus Pinkwater, *Not a Box* by Antoinette Portis, *Drawn Together* by Minh Le, and *What to do with an Idea* by Kobi Yamada. *The Big Orange Splot* is a silly story about a man who is very creative in painting his house - over and over again. *Not a Box* is a fun story about a rabbit that thinks outside the box about a box. *Drawn Together* is a heartwarming story about a boy and his grandfather who struggle to communicate due to a language barrier and discover that they are able to communicate and connect through collaborative drawings. *What to do with an Idea* is a beautiful story about the impact an idea can have on the world. You might ask your child about the story their class read.
