#### Parking Lot Safety:

There has been an increase in parking lot drop offs in the mornings. This is extremely unsafe to stop in the middle of the parking lot to drop off your child when other cars are attempting to park. Cars should **NOT** stop at the crosswalk to let kids get out of their car. **Options:** 

- 1) Carpool Lane: cars pull up along the curb so the children can exit the car safely on the sidewalk.
- 2) Pull into the parking lot and park in a designated parking spot and walk your child from the parking lot over to the entrance of school.

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


