Dear Sycamore Families:

REMINDERS:

No School - Monday, Sept. 5th - Labor Day

Covid Reporting:

Health and safety remain a priority for our district. As such, we ask that parents/caregivers continue to report all positive student cases to your school office. All reported cases will be tracked on the District's COVID-19 Dashboard and reported in the County.

More Safety Updates:

Fire Lane Gate:

The fire lane gates will be open from 7:45-8:10 each morning and again at dismissal. The gates will be secured during the school day, evenings and weekends.

Please note, we strongly encourage parents to use the front and the back path entrance to the black top. We do not provide supervision on the fire

lane. Supervision is only provided on the black top and at the front of school during arrival and dismissal. Children should not be playing in the ditch next to the fire lane as it is unsafe. We are asking that parents provide appropriate supervision if you choose to use the fire lane. Should issues arise around the use of the fire lane then we will revisit the topic.

• Kids Country Parking Lot:

Starting Tuesday, Sept. 6th, the Kids Country parking lot will have cones to close off the entrance, starting at 2:00pm. If you are parking in the synagogue parking lot, near the kindergarten playground, you must turn right when exiting the parking lot. We are initiating this procedure again this year as many cars have not been following signage to turn right when exiting the Kids Country parking lot. Cars have tried to drive straight across traffic which is not safe.


