Drop Off:

The drop off and pick up line can be frustrating for everyone but we ask you to keep the following things in mind in order to keep everyone safe!

Crosswalk: Please cross only at the cross walks. It is not safe to cross at the top of the lane by the entrance to the playground. It also slows traffic as cars that are exiting have to stop for pedestrians.

Fire lane: Please do not pull up into the red fire lane. That lane must remain clear in case of an emergency.

Do not cut the line from lane 2 and 3 and pull in front of other cars. It is unsafe as cars are not expecting someone to be pulling in front of them from the left lane as they are trying to pull out from the curb.

Registration opens on September 20 at 7pm.




